MASSAGES

A large variety to meet the specific needs of everyone

Massage is an intuitive healing art which has been part of daily life for thousands of years. The origins are often traced back some 4,000 years to a Chinese medical text, the Cong Pu of the Tao Tse which detailed some of the first recorded massage techniques.

In Western culture, more recent references date back to Hippocrates around 400BC who wrote about the medical value of promoting even blood flow around the body.

The Middle Ages were a dark time generally, and massage practices fell out of use at a time when religious practices forbid touching others.

Although Swede Pehr Henrik Ling is often credited with being the founder of the modern massage, his field was more physical education, and his 'Swedish Movement System' has been conflicted with Dutch practitioner Johan Georg Mezger who actually classified the techniques.

Regardless of the origins, there are now around 70 distinct massage techniques practiced around the world, from stone to Californian to pregnancy to reflexology and Reiki (to name just a few).

Moroccan massages

These massages incorporate traditional Moroccan techniques and use local Argon oil, leaving you feeling deeply relaxed and recharged.

INTENSIVE MASSAGES

Our intensive massage treatments are aimed at the deeper tissue structures of the muscle and fascia, also called connective tissue, to release chronic muscle tension or 'knots' (also known as 'adhesions').

Throughout the treatment 'trigger' pressure points are worked on in conjunction with deeper moves, all of which are designed to release the pressure within the muscles.

Intensive massage treatments often involve the use of forearms and elbows throughout the routine.

Our therapists are trained in these specialised techniques and use specific Aromatherapy Associates products, designed to work in conjunction with the movements.
